



Hybrid PDF Documents

Feature	Description
Universal PDF compatibility	A Hybrid PDF is a PDF document that can be opened by any PDF program (such as Adobe Acrobat Reader).
Full editable file format	In addition to being a PDF file, a Hybrid PDF file contains a full copy of the file in Open Document Format.
Best file format used by each application	A PDF reader program will only read the PDF content of the file. But when a Hybrid PDF is opened in OpenOffice.org 3, it will be a fully featured (and fully editable file), based on the included Open Document Format information stored in the Hybrid PDF.
Limitations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To generate Hybrid PDF files, you need to have installed the Sun PDF Import Extension into Open Office.• Hybrid PDFs are not currently readable by all Open Document Format editing programs.

Hybrid PDF documents can be created by the Sun PDF Import Extension to Open Office 3.x.

This extension to Open Office provides a number of other features: including a way of editing “standard” PDF documents. There are many limitations when you try to edit a “standard” PDF document. It's only when you use a Hybrid PDF document that you will get a PDF file that is easy to edit.
